August 16, 1984 – July 13, 2009

In June of 2009 our lives rocked with unexpected change as Brandon suffered a devastating stroke in the same site as his original brain tumor. Our hearts broke as we made the necessary decisions and set up the hospice care. During the next 20 days we were held by so many family and friends who came to sing the prayers around his bed, read his favorite stories, and share their precious memories. On July 13th he healed into death. July 18th we ritualized his life's journey in a service at Calvary Baptist Church. July 23rd was the 20th anniversary of his cancer diagnosis. August 16th, he would have turned 25. It's been so much to holdemotionally and spiritually.

We are once again busy with work and all the ordinary rhythms of living. We are experiencing pilgrimages within pilgrimages as we seek to be intentional on this journey of joy and grief in the midst of daily life.

Thank you to all who contributed to Brandon's memorial funds. Enough money has come into The Children's Hospital Handicap Sports Program to purchase a bright green sit-ski, soon to be christened "Brandon's Flyer." Books and money continue to come into Calvary Baptist Church of Denver for the children's library in the Republic of Georgia. Thank you for your part in passing on the love in this way.
